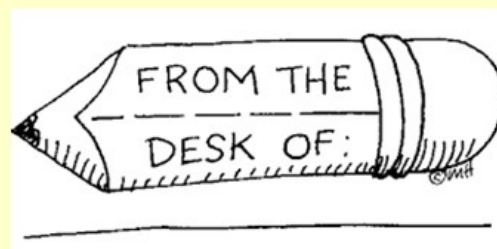
We have 2 Small Groups that meet during the week. One online and the other in person. If you would like to know more about them, please ask and I will guide you to the folks who have the answers.

WORSHIP

Perhaps you have heard that Trinity has a Worship Committee and wondered, just what does that involve? What do you agree to do if you serve on the Worship Committee? Why do we need a Worship Committee?

The Worship Committee's main area of focus is "support and coordination of worship ministries that are planned and implemented by others." Committee members are not expected to preach or even read a liturgy, but they ensure that others are available to perform all the tasks related to creating a meaningful worship experience. Worship Committee members include those responsible for video and sound support, ushers, choir members, musicians, acolytes, altar care and communion stewards, liturgists or lay readers, and others. The committee coordinates with the pastor and music leader to make sure we have all the items and "people support" needed for worship. Think of us as the planners who ensure that all the components are available for worship and that responsible parties are prepared so the service will run smoothly.

We meet quarterly and try to look ahead on the church calendar to prepare for upcoming liturgical seasons and church events. For example, at our August meeting we discussed a future concert series, Advent worship and more.

The Worship Committee reports activities to the Council on Ministries. Co-chairs are Pat Gillespie and Teresa Gross.
