Core Responsibilities

Weekly Programming: Plan, organize, and execute the weekly youth group gathering, including teaching relevant, Bible-based lessons, leading group discussions, and organizing games.

Discipleship & Mentorship: Be involved in the lives of the youths of the church. Be intentional and encouraging.

Parent Collaboration: Create group text with parents to inform and have open communication.

Volunteer Coordination: Strive to invite others to help with youth ministry.

Special Events: Go to Resurrection in January. Plan other events throughout year.

Church Alignment: Must attend monthly leadership/ministry meetings. Be aligned with Church mission statement.

Faith & Character: Strong, visible, growing Christian witness committed to biblical values.

Communication Skills: Strong verbal communication skills, with the ability to teach scripture in a way that is engaging and accessible to adolescents. Be relatable and genuine.
